**RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
OF THE MASON-LAKE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT**

A Regular meeting of the Board of Education of said District was held in the District's Conference Room, 2130 West US 10, Ludington, MI 49431, on the 29th day of June 2010 at 5:50 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Catherine Becker.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member Bass and supported by Member Dittmer:

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be the general appropriations act of the Mason-Lake Intermediate School District for the fiscal year July 1, 2010-June 30, 2011; AN ACT to make appropriations; to provide for the expenditures of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of all income received by the Mason-Lake Intermediate School District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total revenues and unappropriated fund balance estimated to be available for appropriations in the general education fund of the Mason-Lake Intermediate School District for the fiscal year July 1, 2010-June 30, 2011, is as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that \$2,538,802 of the total available to appropriate in the general fund is hereby appropriated in the amounts and for the purposes set forth below:

FURTHER RESOLVED, that no Board member or employee of the school district shall expend any funds or obligate the expenditure of any funds except pursuant to appropriations made by the Board of Education and in keeping with the budgetary policy statement hitherto adopted by the Board. Changes in the amount appropriated by the Board shall require approval by the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent is hereby charged with general supervision of the execution of the budget adopted by the Board and shall hold the department heads responsible for performance of their responsibilities within the amounts appropriated by the Board of Education and in keeping with the budgetary policy statement hitherto adopted by the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for purposes of meeting emergency needs of the school district, changes in appropriations may be made upon the written authorization of the Superintendent. When the Superintendent makes a change in appropriations as permitted by the resolution, such change shall be presented to the Board of Education in the form of an appropriations act amendment, which shall be adopted by the Board of Education at a regularly scheduled meeting.

This act is to take effect on July 1, 2010.

All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this Resolution be and the same are hereby rescinded.
